THE FILM "ADAPTATION TO CLIMATE CHANGE IN THE PAMIRS" WAS SCREENED AT THE INTERNATIONAL FESTIVAL IN KHOROG

On July 27, in the framework of the International Annual Festival of Music, Culture and Nature "Roof of the World", the film "Adaptation to Climate Change in the Pamirs" was shown in the Park of Culture and Recreation in Khorog.

The show took place in the building of the Pamir Ecocultural Tourist Association (PECTA). The film tells about measures to restore forests and shore protection in the Bartang valley of GBAO, as well as to increase the capacity of local residents to adapt to climate change. The film was produced by director Tolik Gadomadov and employees of the Public Foundation CAMP Tabiat as part of the project "Ecosystem –based Adaptation to Climate Change in High Mountainous Regions of Central Asia" (EBA).

The project is implemented by the German Society for International Cooperation (GIZ) in Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan on behalf of the German government. In Tajikistan GIZ partner in the project implementation is CAMP Tabiat.

The "Roof of World" festival is aimed at preserving and developing the musical and dancing traditions of the peoples of the Pamir and other regions of Tajikistan, as well as the countries of Central and South Asia. The event also promotes cultural exchange between different countries through the organization of performances by musical groups, film screenings, folk craft exhibitions and master classes.
