PEOPLE OF BARTANG VALLEY WATCHED MOVIE ABOUT PROTECTING THE ENVIRONMENT

21 of December in the village Darjhomj, Bartang Valley, Rushan district, GBAO, Tajikistan - show of documentaries about combating desertification and protecting ecosystems were shown to children and elder people. This movie show was organized by public organization CAMP Tabiat.

People of Darjhomj watched a documentary “Losing ground” which tells about different people fighting against land degradation and effects of climate change in different parts of the world. Film was made by “Along Mekong Production, Heidelberg” for German Society for International Cooperation (GIZ) with order of Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development of Germany. The film was shown to familiarize local residents with successful examples and experiences in solving environmental problems that are also relevant in Tajikistan.

In the same day, for upper class students of Darjhomj village a movie called “Ecosystem services” was shown. It tells about the great importance of ecosystem for people and the need for its protection. According to CAMP Tabiat’s Project Assistant Shodikhon Mirzohasanov, showing children’s films about environment is focused at increase in knowledge about environment and growing children in the direction of protecting the environment.

Children’s film from series of “This? Logic!” filmed in Kyrgyzstan with the help of Regional program GIZ on sustainable use of natural resources in Central Asia from funds of German government.

Films were shown by the project "Ecosystem –based Adaptation to Climate Change in High Mountainous Regions of Central Asia" (EbA), which is implemented by GIZ in Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan with on behalf of German government. In Tajikistan partner of GIZ for realization of the projects is CAMP Tabiat – a subsidiary of CAMP Alatoo Public Fund.
