ACTIVISTS OF VILLAGES SIPONJ AND DARJOMJ OF BARTANG VALLEY GOT AWARDED WITH EbA PROJECT CERTIFICATES

On December 21, the PF CAMP Tabiat presented certificates to about 30 residents of the villages of Siponj and Darjomj for their active participation and assistance in carrying out activities within the framework of the project "Ecosystem –based Adaptation to Climate Change in High Mountainous Regions of Central Asia" (EbA).

Along with the letters, activists of two villages also received memorable gifts – a calendar with photos of local residents in the course of project activities and CDs with films on environmental issues.

All awarded residents of the villages of Siponj and Darjomj took an active part in the project activities on adaptation to climate change and the restoration of rural infrastructure, as well as in seminars and trainings. In particular, they made a worthy contribution to restoring the irrigation canal and forest in the village of Siponj, strengthening the channel of the mountain water flow and creating a forest area in the village Darjomj. As noted by local residents, the high rating of their activities motivates them to achieve even better results.

The presentation of certificates took place within the framework of the EbA project, which is being implemented by the German Society for International Cooperation (GIZ) in Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan on behalf of the German government. In Tajikistan, GIZ's partner in the project is CAMP Tabiat, a branch of the CAMP Alatau Public Foundation.
