BARTANG HOSTED AN ENVIRONMENTAL CHILDREN'S DRAWING COMPETITION

On April 27 in Siponj village of Bartang valley, Rushan district, GBAO the results of ecological competition of children's drawings "Restoration and protection of forest in our village" are summed up.

About 60 high school students from Siponj and Darjomj villages presented more than 100 drawings depicting local nature to the contest. Correspondence of the drawings to the theme of the contest, their originality and artistic characteristics were assessed by the jury members - artist Yorali Berdov, teachers of the local school and employees of CAMP Tabiat.

The winners of the contest were Mustafo Shakarmamadov from Siponj village and Nizori Fozil from Darjomj village. Also, some students received prizes, such as Shukrona Pallayev and Nurangezi Davlatsho from Darjomj, Andi Tojiddinov and Payshanbei Nisormamad from Siponj.

Director of CAMP Tabiat Umed Bulbulshoyev presented the winners of the competition, as well as their teachers on drawing with memorable prizes. Also, all students participating in the contest received colored pencils and albums.

On the same day, an exhibition was organized in the village club of Siponj, where drawings of all participants of the competition were presented. The exhibition was attended by a large number of visitors, mainly children, who showed genuine interest in bright and colorful drawings.

According to U. Bulbulshoev, "the creative competition and exhibition of children's drawings were organized in order to attract the attention of local residents - children and adults - to the issues of conservation, restoration and protection of forests in the region. In addition, such events contribute to the environmental education of the younger generation and the development of their creative abilities."

The contest and exhibition of children's drawings were organized by CAMP Tabiat within the framework of the project "Ecosystem –based Adaptation to Climate Change in High Mountainous Regions of Central Asia" (EbA). The EbA project is implemented by the German Society for International Cooperation (GIZ) in Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan on behalf of the German government. In Tajikistan, the GIZ partner in the project implementation is CAMP Tabiat.
