FILMS ON CLIMATE CHANGE ADAPTATION WERE SCREENED AT THE UNIVERSITY OF KHOROG

On 3-4 April, documentaries on climate change adaptation and ecosystem services were shown to students of Khorog State University (KSU).

On the first day, students of the Faculty of Biology, specializing in Ecology and Geography, watched the film "Adaptation to Climate Change in the Pamirs". The film tells about measures to restore forests and shore protection in the Bartang valley of the Rushan district of GBAO, as well as to increase the resilience of local residents to climate change. The film was prepared by director Tolik Gadomadov and employees of the CAMP Tabiat Public Foundation as part of the project "Ecosystem –based Adaptation to Climate Change in High Mountainous Regions of Central Asia" (EbA).

The next day, KSU students were shown educational films on the topics of "Climate Change" and "Ecosystem Services", which focused on topical issues such as adaptation to the current and future impacts of climate change. They also describe the gifts of nature on which people's lives directly depend and the need to preserve and multiply them for the benefit of present and future generations.

Screenings of ecological films are organized with the purpose of assistance to increase the level of ecological education of young generation.

The screening was followed by discussions on climate change adaptation and sustainable use of natural resources with students and teachers from the Faculty of Biology of KSU.

The films were shown as part of the EbA project, which is being implemented by GIZ in Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan on behalf of the German government. In Tajikistan, GIZ's partner in the project is CAMP Tabiat, a branch of the CAMP Alatau Public Foundation.
